

Thinking Abilities and General Knowledge Activity for 12 to 18 Months

Easy-Shape Boxes

When cans and lids are played with separately, this is a fine-motor activity. If you use them together, this becomes a cognitive activity as children discover which object goes into which hole.

Materials:

- Two coffee cans with lids
- Baby-food jar lids
- Old-fashioned wooden clothespins
- Sharp knife

To make:

- 1. File any sharp edges on the cans, if necessary
- 2. Cut a slot hole in the lid of one can for the baby-food jar lids, and a small hole in the other lid for clothespins.

What to do:

- 1. Allow the child to play with the cans and their contents separately, simply enjoying sticking the objects through the lid.
- 2. Put the cans, the baby-food jar lids, and clothespins in front of the child. Have the lids on the cans.
- 3. Show the child how to make the objects go through the slot, if she has difficulty.

Variation:

Cut a slot in a shoebox just the right width and length to fit the lids through.
